


IIM MUMBAI COMMEMORATES ANTI-RAGGING DAY WITH ENGAGING INITIATIVES

The paper, authored by Puja Sarkar and guided by Prof. Vivekanand Khanapuri and Prof. Manoj Tiwari, exemplifies a rigorous research journey. Throughout maintained the Sarkar process. composure and responded diligently to comments. ultimately convincing the reviewers of the paper's value. The research underscores the essential integration of prediction and optimization in decision-making, arguing that traditional machine learning models often emphasize minimizing prediction over decision errors errors. innovative methodology applies downstream optimization task with all constraints as a loss function for training the machine learning model, suggesting promising future applications.

The journey began with the submission of the paper on July 3, 2023. Following multiple rounds of review, includina feedback from three referees and the Area Editor, the paper underwent significant revisions. While one referee provided feedback. unfavorable two others recommended major improvements. After four rounds of revisions, assisted by input from a neutral referee, the paper received final acceptance. This process proved to be a lengthy yet rewarding learning experience, with the manuscript totaling pages and the response sheet extending to 37 pages.



THE INDIAN Institute of Management (IIM) Mumbai has announced an infrastructure development plan worth Rs 800 crore, to be executed in three phases over the next five years. This initiative aims to enhance the institute's academic and res-idential facilities and introduce new amenities such as an incubation centre, research laborato ries and an amphitheatre. The expansion also includes plans to offer additional courses, includ-ing undergraduate education and executive programmes, for

industry professionals.
Established in 1963 as the
National Institute of Industrial Engineering (NITIE), IIM Mumbai achieved the status of an IIM in August of the previous year, becoming the newest IIM

The institute's comprehen-sive overhaul will include the development of world-class academic and residential facilities, a start-up ecosystem, and ad-vanced research amenities. Notable additions will be an Innovation Centre focused on banking, finance, and fintech an Al-based research hub, and a

state-of-the-art library. Director of IIM Mumbai, Prof Manoj Kumar Tiwari out-Prof Manoj Kumar Hwari Out-lined the funding strategy for the projects. "We have an ini-tial corpus of Rs 100 crore. An additional Rs 200 crore will be raised through the Higher **Education Financing Agency** (HEFA), a joint venture of the Government of India and Government of India aim canara Bank for financing edu-cational infrastructure. We also expect to secure Rs 300 crore through Viability Gap Funding (VCF)," he said. Prof. Tiwari noted that the in-

stitute is collaborating with in-dustry partners, some of whom have expressed interest in fund-ing and naming rights for vari-

"Most business houses are headquartered in Mumbai and are looking to partner with a leading management institute, not only for recruiting trained manpower but also for executive capacity building." he said.
